- We are not allowing people to linger in our waiting rooms. Please check in at the check in window. We are allowing clients inside the clinic one at a time. We will get you in an exam room as soon as one becomes available.
- Practice "social distancing." There will be no handshaking, fist bumps, high-fives, or hugs.
- Pet medications that are called in can be picked up at our check in window. We also highly recommend that you look at our online pharmacy -[fernleyvets.vetsfirstchoice.com](http://fernleyvets.vetsfirstchoice.com) – your pet's medications and food can be delivered right to your front door.
- We will not be able to accommodate entire families coming in for pet appointments. It will be limited to one adult per pet.
- If your pet is hospitalized with us, we will not allow personal objects such as toys and bedding.
- We are doing the best we possibly can to provide essential services for your pets. Please be patient and kind as we navigate the unknown.
